RIDE FOR LIFE 2018 RULES/HEALTH & SAFETY POLICY

THE ORGANISER HAS OVERALL RESPONSIBILITY FOR HEALTH & SAFETY.

THE EVENT IS ORGANISED IN ACCORDANCE WITH HEALTH AND SAFETY LEGISLATION AND ALL WHO HAVE, TO ANY EXTENT, CONTROL OF THE PREMISES, OR SITE ON WHICH THE EVENT ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ENSURING THAT: EVERYTHING REASONABLY PRACTICABLE IS DONE TO ENSURE HEALTH, SAFETY AND WELFARE OF THOSE ATTENDING THE EVENT

THEY CONDUCT THEMSELVES SO THAT THEY DO NOT PUT THEMSELVES OR ANYONE ELSE AT RISK. THE ACCESS TO AND EGRESS FROM THE SITE IS SAFE AND UNOBSTRUCTED.

DOGS SHOULD BE KEPT UNDER CLOSE CONTROL AND ON A SHORT LEAD. THE DANGEROUS DOGS ACT NOW COVERS PRIVATE LAND (NOV 2014).

RIDERS MUST KEEP TO MARKED ROUTE AND OBEY INSTRUCTIONS FROM ORGANISERS AND STEWARDS.

BRITISH STANDARD HARD HATS PAS 015: 1998 OR 2011 OR VG1 01.040: 2014-12 PROVIDED THAT THEY ARE BSI KITEMARKED OR INSPEC IC MARKED MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES WHEN MOUNTED.

- THE ROUTE WILL BE CHECKED FOR POTENTIAL HAZARDS SUCH AS RABBIT HOLES AND EVERY EFFORT WILL BE MADE TO CLEARLY MARK THESE BUT RIDERS ARE REMINDED TO KEEP A LOOKOUT.
- NO VEHICLES, DOGS OR PEDESTRIANS ARE ALLOWED ON THE MARKED ROUTE.
- NO STALLIONS. HORSES/PONIES MUST BE OVER AGE OF 4 TO TAKE PART IN THE RIDE.
- ANY RIDER MISUSING SPURS/WHIPS WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE.
- RIDERS ARE EXPECTED TO RESPECT OTHERS ON THE RIDE. ANY RIDERS BEHAVING IN SUCH A WAY AS TO ENDANGER THEMSELVES, THEIR HORSES OR OTHER RIDERS WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE.
- NO LUNGING IN THE PARKING AREA.
- RIDERS UNDER 16 YRS MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY AN ADULT. NO LEAD REIN RIDERS.
- ROAD CROSSINGS WILL BE MANNED AND FIRST AIDERS IN ATTENDANCE.
- M&DRC HAS TAKEN ALL REASONABLE PRECAUTIONS TO ENSURE THE HEALTH & SAFETY OF EVERYONE PRESENT BUT RIDERS ARE REMINDED THAT RIDING IS A HIGH RISK SPORT AND ALL ACTIVITIES ARE UNDERTAKEN AT THE RIDER'S RISK. RIDERS ARE ADVISED TO CARRY THEIR OWN HORSE AND RIDER LIABILITY INSURANCE. M&DRC DO NOT ACCEPT LIABILITY FOR ANY ACCIDENT/INJURY TO RIDERS, SPECTATORS, HORSES OR PROPERTY.

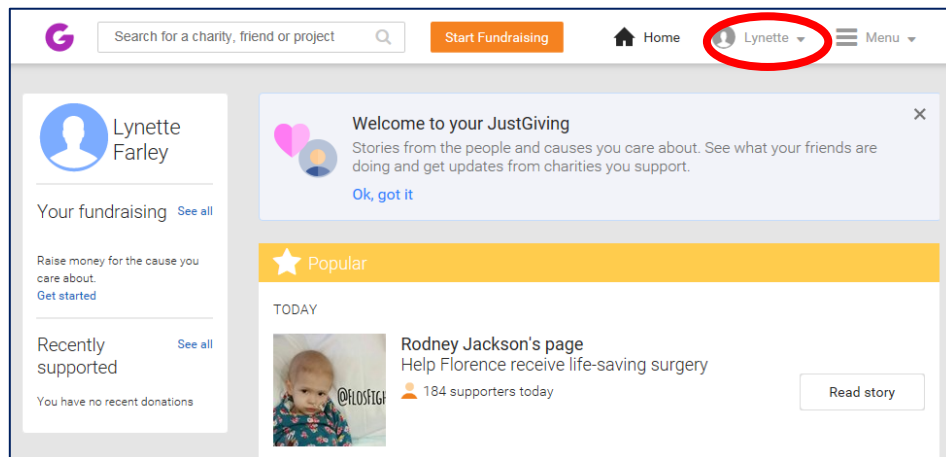

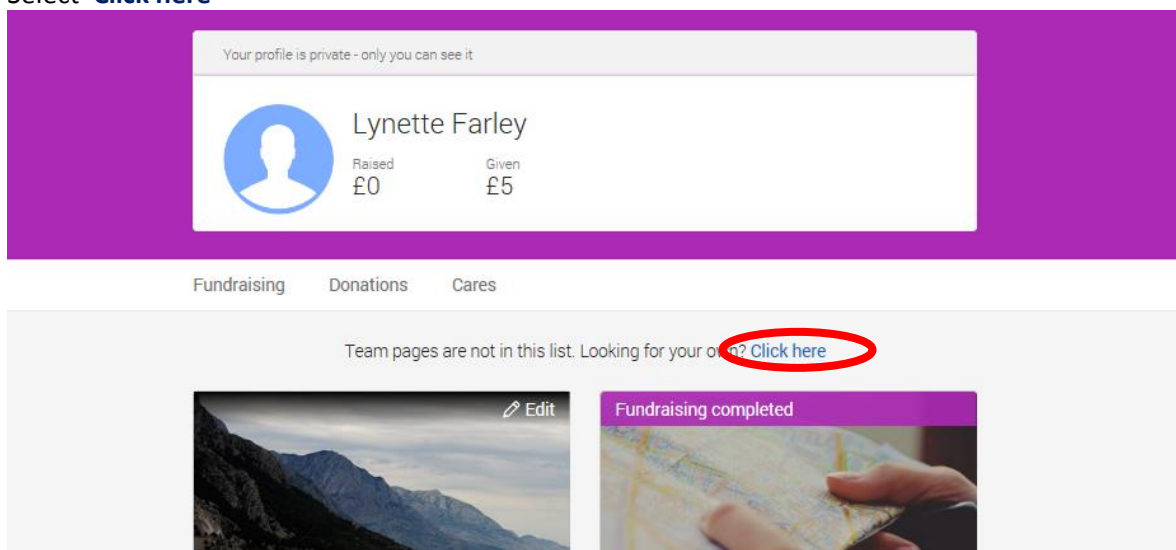
By creating a JustGiving page, you will be able to raise your fundraising profile further and spread the word Ride For Life 2018.

To create your own JustGiving page to collect sponsorship for Ride For Life, please follow the simple instructions below (it looks complicated, but it really isn't!):


1. Go to www.justgiving.com
2. Select '**Sign Up**' or '**Log In**' to create or access your JG account
3. Once you are logged in, **select your name** in top right corner



4. Select '**Your Fundraising**'
5. Select '**Click here**'




6. Select **'Start a New Team'**

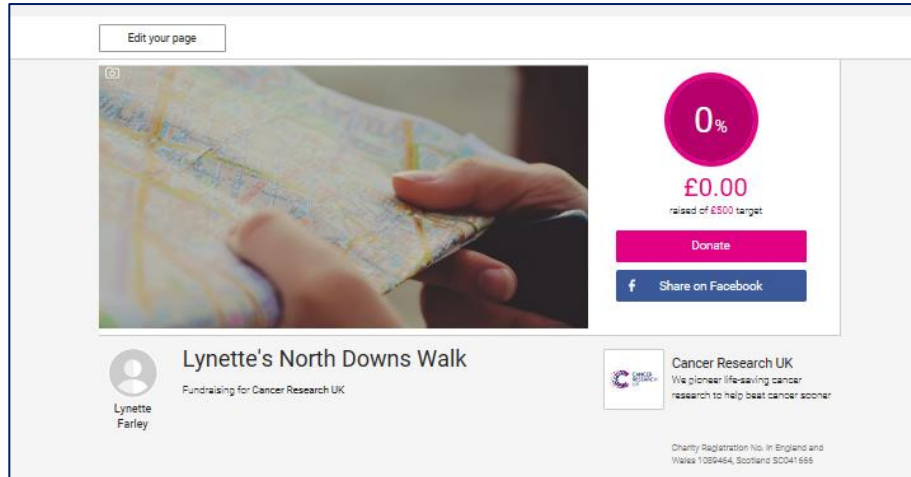

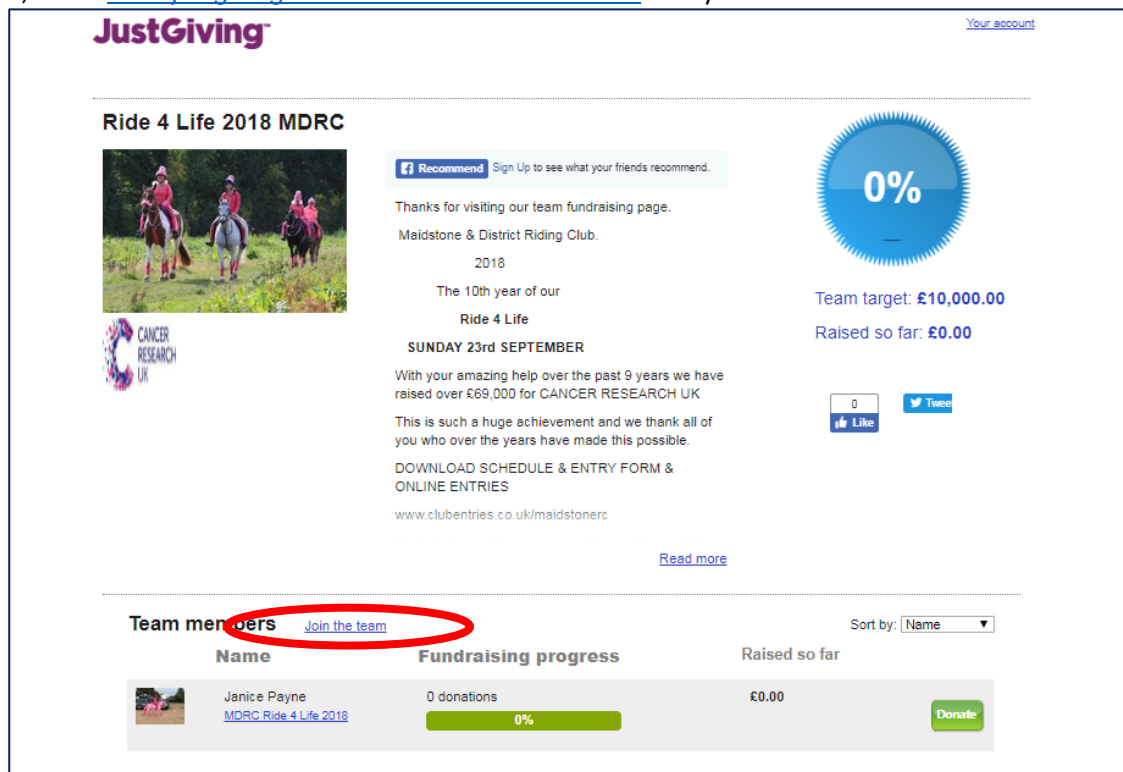
14. Select **'Create your page'**

(You now have your own fundraising page which needs to be linked to the Ride For Life Team page)




15. Now, enter www.justgiving.com/teams/ride4life2018mdrc into your address bar


